A Plenary Indulgence is granted to those Catholics who visit the Basilica of St. Lawrence Parish on August 10 and fulfill the following requirements:

- 1. The faithful must be in union with the Church
- 2. The faithful must do the "prescribed indulgenced act." For the Feast of St. Lawrence the "act" is to visit the Basilica and participate in Holy Mass, a Liturgical Service or at least to pray the "Our Father" and the "Profession of Faith."
- 3. The faithful must fulfill the "prescribed conditions" for every plenary indulgence:
 - a. have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin;
 - b. have sacramentally confessed their sins; (preferably on the same day as doing the prescribed "work", but this may be done 20 days before or after the "work."
 - c. receive the Holy Eucharist (preferably on the same day as doing the prescribed "work", but this may be done 20 days before or after the "work.")
 - d. pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff. (An "Our Father" and "Hail Mary" would suffice. preferably on the same day as doing the prescribed "work", but this may be done 20 days before or after the "work.")

One Plenary Indulgence can be gained in one day, except in danger of death.
